## Diagon Alley

- Let a wand choose you at **Ollivander's Wand Shop**.
- Use your interactive wand at the storefront of the **Slug and Jiggers Apothecary** or **Scribbulus Writing Implements**.
- Find Luna Lovegood's beloved Crumple-Horned Snorkack and the snake that speaks in both English and Parseltongue at the **Magical Menagerie**.
- Watch the window at **12 Grimmauld Place**, Sirius Black's family home.
- Find the Peruvian Instant Darkness Powder at **Weasley's Wizard Wheezes**. While you are there, look to the skylight for a surprise and keep an eye out for the terrible Professor Umbridge on her unicycle.
- Stand under the sign at the **Leaky Cauldron**, then order a butterbeer.
- Find pennants from the quidditch teams seen in the movies at **Quality Quidditch Supplies**.
- Seek out **Knockturn Alley**. Use the black lights to find secret spell locations.
- Ask the goblin in **Gringotts Money Exchange** if he is a house elf. You can exchange your muggle money for wizard cash to be used in the park.
- Try on a robe at **Madam Malkin's Robes for All Occasions**. Ask the mirror how you look.
- Dial 62442 (MAGIC) at the red phone booth outside of **Kings Cross**.
- Find Hedwig (Harry Potter's Owl) waiting on the platform at **Kings Cross**.

## Hogsmeade

- Approach the The Monster Book of Monsters in **Dervish and Banges**. Go on, get close.
- Mail a postcard from the **Owl Post** with an official Hogsmeade stamp. Stand around too long, though and you might get a Howler.
- Buy some Bertie Bott's Every-Flavor Beans at **Honeyduke's** and try to guess the flavor.
- Ride **Hagrid's Magical Creatures Motorbike Adventure** and **Forbidden Journey**. Watch the pre-show for both of these rides. Be sure to listen at the potions classroom door while waiting for the Forbidden Journey.
- Ask a **cast member wearing your Hogwarts house colors** to teach you the secret handshake.
- Kick back another butterbeer and traditional wizarding food at the **Three Broomsticks** while watching for house elf shadows as they prepare your food.
- Listen to Moaning Myrtle's reminders in the **restrooms**.
- Watch the **Nighttime Lights on Hogwarts Castle**. Cheer extra loudly when your house is featured. Listen carefully to the narration by the Sorting Hat and the musical accompaniment of John Williams's musical score. The best (and most crowded) viewing area is in front of the Frog Choir/Triwizard Spirit Rally stage. The last show of the night is the least crowded.
